PLANNING AND SCHEDULING MEETING WABASH VALLEY MASTER GARDENER ASSOCIATION March 20, 2018, 6:30pm, 4-H meeting Room Vigo County Fairgrounds

Meeting called to order at 6:30pm by President Phil Small.

<u>EDUCATIONAL TIME – 1.25 hours.</u> Vice-President Ruth Bohner introduced our speakers, Ryan Wickens of the Vigo County Department of Area Planning and Len Mullins, Wabash Valley Bee Club who discussed zoning policies for Bee keeping in Vigo County. They spoke about set backs (number of feet hive should be set back from roads and property). They said that there should only be two hives per acre and it is important to have a water source for the bees.

They demonstrated some of the elements of a hive. They noted that bees are pests for some people and farm animals for others. There are a lot of government coverage standards (zoning) for agriculture. Len Mullins said that there is a bee hive on top of the Terre Haute Children's Museum and more at St. Mary of the Woods. He noted that pollinators are very important in the production of food. At the end of his comments, he asked if we had heard of the bee that went to the dermatologist. It was because he had hives. HaHa!

Minutes: Published in the March 2018 Gazette. Two corrections were noted.

Recording Secretary: Carole passed around an attendance sheet.

Vice President: Ruth said that the speaker for March would discuss native orchids and noted that there will be no speaker at the May meeting because it will be a picnic (carry-in) to celebrate the Intern Graduation.

Corresponding Secretary: Verna said that he had recently sent out an updated membership roster and a list of committee members.

Treasurer: Brenda said that she had changed the address for receiving mail for the treasurer from Mary Beth Prickel's address to the Master Gardener's Post Office Box address. She gave the Parks Board our tax exempt code. She said that we had made about \$1,000 on the Gardeners Gathering. She said that she and Mary Beth had met recently and sent an updated roster to Verna. They checked with some people who have not yet paid their dues. She sent thank you cards to Gardeners Gathering sponsors.

Larry Agee, Head Bedkeeper said that a bill for \$50 for planting material had been sent to the Parks Department.

<u>Spring Seminar</u>: Phil expressed thanks to all the members who spent a lot of time working on this event. Ninety people attended 1 or more events. The vendors needed more support. We need to promote the fact that the Gathering is for the community, not just Master Gardeners. The date for next year's event is set for March 9, 2019. At this time a few people shared their experience attending the recent seminar at Putnam County.

Website: Sam reported that everything is fine.

OLD BUSINESS:

 Carole Dreher passed around photos from Arts Illiana Table Scapes and thanked the committee that worked with her on this event – Nancy Nation, Mary Beth Prickel and Sharon Polge. She also thanked members that attended and voted for our table.

NEW BUSINESS:

 Ruth Bohner and Shannon Giles have been working with some of the schools on "After School Gardeners" projects. These clubs usually meet from 4:00 – 4:30pm.
